Joint State Action

In joint Oregon and Washington state action; the states discussed the following mainstem Columbia recreational fishery and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fisheries

The Bonneville Pool Sturgeon Fishery (Bonneville Dam to The Dalles Dam)

- Effective 12:01 AM Saturday June 6, 2009 the retention of white sturgeon in the Columbia River and tributaries between Bonneville and The Dalles dams will be prohibited. Catch and release fishing will be allowed throughout the remainder of the year.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 2:30 PM Wednesday June 10, 2009 to consider treaty Indian and non-treaty summer Chinook commercial fisheries.
