Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today to review the ongoing non-Indian commercial fisheries and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Fall Chinook Commercial Fishery

- Modified the previously non-Indian commercial fishery. Modification in **bold**.

Area: **August 9-10, 2009: Zones 2-5.**

August 18-24, 2009: Zones 3-5, upstream of the Kalama River (upstream of a line projected from the Goble Ramp on the Oregon Shore to the downstream end of the Kalama Chemical dock on the Washington shore).

August 25-28, 2009: Zones 4-5.

- All sanctuaries, gear, allowable sales, miscellaneous regulations and reporting rule presented in the July 29, 2009 Columbia River Fishery Notice remain unchanged.
