Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today to review the ongoing non-Indian commercial fisheries and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Fall Chinook Commercial Fishery

- **Rescinded** the previously adopted non-Indian commercial fishing period.

Season: 8 PM Sunday August 23 to 6 AM Monday August 24 (10 hrs)

Area: August 18-24, 2009: Zones 3-5, upstream of the Kalama River (upstream of a line projected from the Goble Ramp on the Oregon Shore to the downstream end of the Kalama Chemical dock on the Washington shore).

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 11 AM Monday August 24, 2009 via teleconference to review stock status and non-Indian commercial fisheries.
