Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Commercial Salmon Fishery

- Adopted a commercial gillnet fishing season as follows:

Season:	6 AM Tuesday September 29 to 6 PM Thursday October 1 2.5 days
Area:	All of Zone 6.
Sanctuaries:	All standard dam and river mouth sanctuaries are in effect including the standard (large) Spring Creek Sanctuary.
Gear:	No minimum mesh size restriction.
Allowable Sales:	Chinook, coho, sockeye, steelhead, walleye, carp, yellow perch, catfish, bass and shad may be sold or retained for subsistence use. White sturgeon may not be sold. White Sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools, and white sturgeon between 38-54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool may be kept for subsistence use.
Miscellaneous Regulations:	Fish caught during open fishing periods in the Wind, Klickitat, and White Salmon River tributary fisheries and in subsistence fisheries on the Washington shore below Bonneville Dam will also be allowed.
Washington Reporting:	WDFW adopted a regulation requiring all Washington wholesale buyers purchasing fish from commercial fisheries to send a report of their landings to WDFW within 24 hours of the closure of the fishery via either: a) FAX transmission to (360) 906-6776 or (360) 906-6777 b) E-mail to crfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov c) Telephone to 1-866-791-1281
