## Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington met today via telephone to review the recreational sturgeon fishery in The Dalles Pool and took the following actions:

### Zone 6 Recreational Sturgeon Fisheries

#### **The Dalles Reservoir (The Dalles Dam to John Day Dam)**

- Effective 12:01 AM Thursday May 6, 2010 the retention of sturgeon in the Columbia River and tributaries between The Dalles and John Day dams will be prohibited.

All other permanent angling regulations described in the "2010 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations Pamphlet" remain in effect.
