## Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

### Treaty Indian Fisheries

#### ***Platform and Hook and Line Fisheries***

- The sale of fish caught in the Zone 6 platform and hook-and-line fisheries will be prohibited from 6 PM Friday May 21, 2010 through 6 AM Wednesday June 16, 2010.
- Sales of salmon, steelhead, walleye, shad, carp, bass and yellow perch caught in Yakama Nation tributary fisheries in the Klickitat River, Wind River, Drano Lake, and Big White Salmon River during those days and hours when the tributaries are open under lawfully enacted tribal fishing periods are allowed.

### **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- No Compact/Joint State hearings have been scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff will continue to monitor progress of the spring Chinook run and provide updates and schedule hearings as needed.
