Joint State Action

In joint Oregon and Washington state action the states discussed the following mainstem Columbia non-Indian recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Buoy 10 Recreational Fishery

- No action taken.
- The retention of Chinook salmon (adults and jacks) will close as scheduled effective September 1, 2010 in the area from Buoy 10 upstream to the Tongue Point/Rocky Point line.
- Retention of adipose fin-clipped coho and adipose fin-clipped steelhead is allowed under permanent regulations.
- Other area, gear, and bag limit restrictions remain as per permanent regulations.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 1:00 PM Thursday September 9, 2010 via teleconference to review stock status for Chinook and steelhead and consider additional treaty commercial fishing periods and a review of the lower Columbia River recreational fisheries.
