The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Select Area Commercial Fisheries

- The following fisheries were rescinded by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon or Washington in state waters.

Blind Slough/Knappa Slough Fishery (Zone 74)

- **Rescinded** previously adopted spring season fishing periods from 7 PM to 7 AM on the following nights:

Monday April 25 - Tuesday April 26	(1 night)

Tongue Point/South Channel Select Area Fishery (Zone 71)

- **Rescinded** previously adopted spring season fishing period from 7 PM to 7 AM on the following night:
