## Oregon State Action

In state action Oregon approved the following rule change:

### Treaty Indian Fisheries

#### ***Platform and Hook and Line Fisheries in Zone 6 and Downstream of Bonneville Dam***

Effective 6:00 AM Thursday November 8, 2012 through January 29, 2013 commercial sales of Chinook, coho, steelhead, shad, yellow perch, bass, walleye, catfish and carp may be sold or retained for subsistence use.

Sockeye may not be sold or retained for subsistence use.

White sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length caught in The Dalles and John Day Pools, and white sturgeon between 38-54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool may be kept for subsistence use. Sturgeon caught in the tribal fisheries below Bonneville Dam may not be retained or sold.

Fish may not be sold on USACE property below Bonneville Dam, but may be caught and transported off USACE property for sale.
