Oregon State Action

In state action, Oregon approved the following rule changes:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Winter Gillnet Commercial Fishery

- Modified the season as follows. Modification in **bold**.

Effective **6 AM** Friday, February 1 through 6:00 PM Thursday, March 21, 2013, commercial sales of salmon, steelhead, white sturgeon, walleye, shad, yellow perch, catfish, bass, and carp caught in the Zone 6 treaty Indian gillnet fishery are allowed. White sturgeon between 43-54 inches fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools and white sturgeon between 38-54 inches fork length in the Bonneville Pool may be sold or kept for subsistence use. Allowable sales include fish caught on platform/hook and line gear within the Zone 6 fishing area.

Platform Hook and Line below Bonneville Dam

- Approved sales for the following fishery:

Effective 6 AM Friday, February 1, 2013, commercial sales of salmon, steelhead, walleye, shad, yellow perch, catfish, bass, and carp caught in the tribal fishery downstream of Bonneville Dam are allowed consistent with state/tribal MOU's whenever sales are authorized for platform and hook-and-line fisheries in the remainder of Zone 6. Retention of sturgeon is prohibited. No sales are allowed on COE property at Bonneville Dam.
