Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Winter Gillnet Commercial Fishery

- **Modified** the ongoing treaty Indian winter gillnet commercial season in the John Day Pool as follows. Modification in **bold**.

Season: **Effective 6 PM Wednesday February 27, 2013 the winter commercial gillnet fishery in the John Day Pool will close.**

White sturgeon between 43-54 inches fork length in John Day pool may be retained for subsistence purposes.

Fish caught in the ongoing platform/hook and line fishery may not be sold, but may be kept for subsistence purposes.

- The ongoing commercial gillnet fisheries in Bonneville and The Dalles pools remain open.
