## Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

### 2014 Zone 6 White Sturgeon Recreational Fishery

#### *Bonneville Pool (Winter retention season)*

Season: Monday February 24 through Sunday March 9, 2014 (14 days)

Area: Mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam upstream to The Dalles Dam, including adjacent tributaries.

Allowable Catch: White sturgeon between 38-inches and 54-inches fork length.

#### *The Dalles and John Day Pools*

Per permanent regulations, retention fisheries opened January 1, 2014 until quota is reached.

All other permanent regulations remain in effect including the annual bag limit of two (2) white sturgeon total for all zones statewide.

## **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- There are no Compact/Joint State hearings scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff anticipates a hearing will be needed in March to consider a June retention season in Bonneville Pool and a May-July spawning sanctuary downstream of The Dalles Dam.
