Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Winter Gillnet Commercial Fishery

- **Modified** the ongoing treaty Indian winter gillnet commercial season in the John Day Pool as follows. Modification in **bold**.

Season: Effective 6 PM Wednesday February 26, 2014 the winter commercial gillnet fishery in the John Day Pool will close.

The sale of legal sized sturgeon landed prior to 6 PM on Wednesday is allowed after the fishery closes.

The platform and hook and line fishery in the John Day Pool will remain open for subsistence use. Sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length in John Day pool may be retained for subsistence purposes.

- The ongoing commercial gillnet fisheries in Bonneville and The Dalles pools remain open.
