## Joint State Action

In joint Oregon and Washington state action the states discussed the following recreational fishery and took the following actions:

### ***Bonneville Pool - Sturgeon Spawning Sanctuary***

- Adopted the following annual sturgeon spawning sanctuary downstream of The Dalles Dam:

Angling for sturgeon prohibited during May through July from The Dalles Dam downstream 1.8 miles to a line from the east (upstream) dock at the Port of The Dalles boat ramp straight across to a marker on the Washington shore.

### ***Bonneville Pool - Summer Recreational White Sturgeon Fishery***

- Adopted the following summer recreational sturgeon fishery in the Bonneville Pool:

Season:      Friday June 13 and Saturday June 14, 2014      2 days  
                  Friday June 20 and Saturday June 21, 2014      2 days

Area:          Mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam upstream to The Dalles Dam, including adjacent tributaries.

Angling for sturgeon prohibited during May through July from The Dalles Dam downstream 1.8 miles to a line from the east (upstream) dock at the Port of The Dalles boat ramp straight across to a marker on the Washington shore.

Allowable    White sturgeon between 38-inches and 54-inches fork length.
