Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following actions:

Select Area Fisheries

- The state of Oregon adopted fishing periods in Oregon state waters of Blind Slough.

Blind Slough (Zone 74) Commercial Salmon Fishery

Season: 7 PM Thursday June 25 – 7 AM Friday June 26 (12 hours)
 7 PM Monday June 29 – 7 AM Tuesday June 30 (12 hours)
 7 PM Thursday July 2 – 7 AM Friday July 3 (12 hours)

Area: Blind Slough area is open with a modified lower boundary.
 The lower boundary of the Blind Slough fishing area is defined as the railroad bridge located approximately 1-1/4 miles upstream from the mouth of Blind Slough.

- All other regulations (including gear, allowable sales, transportation, lighted buoys, and Washington Reporting Rule) as previously adopted on January 28, 2015 remain in effect.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Tuesday June 30, 2015 via teleconference to review stock status, consider additional treaty commercial fisheries, and potentially to consider non-Indian fisheries.
- A fall season Compact hearing is scheduled for 10 AM Wednesday July 29, 2015 at the Clark Regional Wastewater District, 8000 NE 52nd Court, Vancouver, Washington 98665 to consider treaty and non-Indian commercial fisheries in the Columbia River and Select Areas.
