Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational White Sturgeon Fisheries

- Effective Saturday July 18, 2015 angling for and retention of, white sturgeon is prohibited in the waters of the Columbia River and adjacent tributaries from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon/Washington border (upstream of McNary Dam).

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 2:00 PM Monday July 20, 2015 via teleconference to consider treaty commercial fisheries.
- A fall season Compact hearing is scheduled for 10 AM Wednesday July 29, 2015 at the Clark Regional Wastewater District, 8000 NE 52nd Court, Vancouver, Washington 98665 to consider treaty and non-Indian commercial fisheries in the Columbia River and Select Areas.
