Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following action:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Fall Commercial Gillnet Salmon Fishery

- Modified the Spring Creek Hatchery fishway sanctuary for the ongoing Treaty mainstem commercial salmon gillnet fishery:
 - Effective 6 AM Friday September 18, 2015, the Spring Creek Hatchery sanctuary is reduced in size to the standard 150-foot radius around the hatchery fishway (ladder).
- All other regulations for the ongoing Treaty fall commercial salmon gillnet fishery previously adopted on September 10, 2015 remain in effect.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 7 PM **today** Thursday September 17, 2015 via teleconference to consider non-Indian commercial gillnet fisheries.
- A Compact hearing will occur the week of September 21 via teleconference to consider treaty commercial fisheries.
