Oregon State Action

The State of Oregon took the following action:

Select Area Commercial Fisheries

Youngs Bay Select Area (Zone 7) Commercial Salmon Fisheries

- Open waters in Youngs Bay are under Oregon State jurisdiction.
- Modified (reduced) the area for the previously adopted winter fishing period as follows. Modification in **bold**.

Winter Season

10 AM – 2 PM Monday March 28 (4 hours)

Open Area: From the first powerlines downstream of the Walluski River upstream to the confluence of the Youngs and Klaskanine rivers. (Walluski Area)

- All other regulations (including gear, allowable sales, reporting rule, and miscellaneous regulations) as previously adopted on January 27, 2016 remain in effect.

FUTURE MEETING

- A Joint State hearing is planned for Thursday April 7, 2016 via teleconference to review salmon and steelhead stock status and consider recreational fishing seasons in the Columbia River.
