Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Select Area Fisheries

- Rescinded or modified previously adopted spring season fishing periods by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon or Washington in state waters.

Youngs Bay Commercial (Zone 7)

- **Rescinded** the following previously adopted spring season fishing periods:
