Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fishery and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Spring Chinook Fisheries

- Extended the ongoing recreational fishery upstream of Bonneville Dam. Modification in **bold**.

Bonneville Dam to Oregon/Washington Border

Area: Tower Island powerlines (approximately 6 miles below The Dalles Dam) upstream to Oregon/Washington border, plus the Oregon and Washington banks between Bonneville Dam and the Tower Island power lines.

Dates: Wednesday March 16 – **Sunday May 8, 2016**.

Catch Limits: Two adult adipose fin-clipped salmonids per day, only one of which may be a Chinook.

- All other permanent regulations in the 2016 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations pamphlet remain in effect, including catch limits for jack salmon.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A hearing may occur as early as Tuesday May 10, 2016 to review stock status and consider non-Indian fisheries.
