Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon and Steelhead Fisheries

- Effective 12:01 AM Saturday November 5 through Saturday December 31 angling for, and retention of, Coho and steelhead is allowed from Buoy 10 to the Highway 395 Bridge near Pasco, Washington.
- The combined daily bag limit is two adult salmonids. Only one hatchery steelhead may be retained per day.
- All other permanent regulations in the 2016 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations pamphlet remain in effect, including catch limits for jack salmon and fin-clip requirements for retained Coho.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No hearings are scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff will recommend additional hearings as needed.
