Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

White Sturgeon Recreational Fisheries

The Dalles Pool (The Dalles Dam upstream to John Day Dam)

- Effective 12:01 AM Saturday January 20, 2018 the retention of white sturgeon in The Dalles Pool and adjacent tributaries is prohibited.
- For all recreational sturgeon fisheries, catch limits, seasonal sturgeon spawning sanctuary closures, and other restrictions in the 2018 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations pamphlet remain in effect the entire year, including catch and release angling allowed during periods closed to sturgeon retention.
