Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Select Area Fisheries

- The following fisheries were rescinded and adopted by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon or Washington in state waters.

Tongue Point/South Channel Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 71)

- **Rescinded** the following previously adopted winter season periods:

South Channel only	7 PM Thursday March 15 – 7 AM Friday March 16	(1 night)
	7 PM Monday March 19 – 7 AM Tuesday March 20	(1 night)

- Adopted the following winter season periods:

Tongue Point and South Channel	7 PM – 11 PM Thursday March 15	(4 hours)
	9 AM – 1 PM Monday March 19	(4 hours)

- Adopted the following winter season period:

South Channel only	7 PM Monday March 26 – 7 AM Tuesday March 27	(1 night)

- All other regulations previously adopted on January 30, 2018 remain in effect.
- Permanent regulations including rules related to transportation and lighted buoys remain in effect.
