Clarified the effective period

IN SEPARATE ACTIONS, THE WASHINGTON AND OREGON DEPARTMENTS OF FISH AND WILDLIFE TOOK THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fishery

Bonneville Dam to Oregon/Washington Border

- Effective 12:01 AM Saturday July 7 **through Tuesday July 31, 2018** the retention of adult Chinook salmon in the mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon Washington border is prohibited.
- The daily adult bag limit remains at two adult fish (hatchery steelhead and sockeye only). All sockeye are considered adults and must be recorded as adults on the combined angling tag.

All other permanent angling regulations described in the "2018 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations Pamphlet" remain in effect, including bag limits for hatchery jack Chinook.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No additional Compact or Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time. The joint staff will monitor fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed. A Compact Hearing may occur on July 10 to consider treaty Indian fisheries.
