## Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following action:

### Treaty Indian Fisheries

- Allowed commercial sales of fish landed in the following fishery:

#### ***Summer Commercial Gillnet Fishery***

**Season:** 6 AM Wednesday July 11 to 6 PM Friday July 13 (2½ days)

**Area:** All of Zone 6.

**Gear:** Set and drift gill nets. No minimum mesh size restriction.

**Sanctuaries:** All standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries applicable to gillnet gear, except the Spring Creek Hatchery sanctuary is not in effect.

**Allowable Sales:** Salmon (all species), steelhead, shad, yellow perch, bass, walleye, catfish, and carp may be sold or retained for subsistence use.

Sturgeon may not be sold. Sturgeon between 38-54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool and sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools may be kept for subsistence use.

Fish landed during open fishing periods may be sold after the period concludes.

**Washington Reporting Rule:** 24-hour quick reporting required for Washington wholesale dealers, per WAC 220-352-180, except landings must be reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket.
