Compact Action

Select Area Fisheries

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters, the state of Oregon or Washington took the following action in state waters:

- Effective 12:00 PM (noon) Thursday, September 13, 2018 the remainder of the fall season commercial fishery in all Select Area fishing sites in Oregon and Washington is rescinded.

Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon Fisheries

Columbia River mouth to the Highway 395 Bridge

- Effective 12:01 AM Thursday September 13, 2018 angling for, and retention of, all salmon and steelhead in the mainstem Columbia River from Buoy 10 upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge near Pasco, Washington is prohibited.

Select Area Recreational Salmon Fisheries

- Effective 12:01 AM Thursday September 13, 2018 angling for, and retention of, all salmon and steelhead in all Select Area fishing sites in Oregon and Washington is prohibited.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 3 PM Wednesday September 12 via teleconference to consider treaty commercial fisheries; however the tribes may request this hearing be rescheduled.
