Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Treaty Indian Fisheries

Allowed commercial sales of fish landed in the following fisheries:

Summer Commercial Gillnet Fishery

Season: 6:00 AM Monday July 1 to 6:00 PM Wednesday July 3 (2½ days)

Area: All of Zone 6.

Gear: Set and drift gill nets. 7-inch minimum mesh size restriction.

Sanctuaries: All standard river mouth and dam sanctuaries applicable to gillnet gear, except the Spring Creek Hatchery sanctuary is not in effect.

Allowable Sales: Salmon (all species), steelhead, shad, yellow perch, bass, walleye, catfish, and carp may be sold or retained for subsistence.

Sturgeon may not be sold. Sturgeon between 38-54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool and sturgeon between 43-54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools may be kept for subsistence use.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No hearings are scheduled at this time. A Compact Hearing will likely occur the week of July 8, 2019 to consider additional treaty commercial fisheries.
