Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fishery

Warrior Rock/Bachelor Island upstream to Bonneville Dam

- Effective 12:01 AM Friday September 6 the retention of all Chinook salmon is prohibited in the mainstem Columbia River from Warrior Rock/Bachelor Island upstream to Bonneville Dam.
- From September 6 through September 30 the daily adult bag limit is two adult hatchery coho.

All other permanent angling regulations described in the "2019 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations Pamphlet" remain in effect, including bag limits for hatchery jack Chinook.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact/Joint State hearing is scheduled for 1 PM September 5 to consider Treaty commercial fisheries and the recreational white sturgeon fishery upstream of the Wauna powerlines.
