## Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

### *Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon Fisheries*

#### Buoy 10 upstream to Bonneville Dam

- No action taken. Per current regulations, retention of all Chinook is closed.

#### Bonneville Dam upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge

- No action taken. Per current regulations, Chinook retention is open until further notice.
