Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Sockeye and Steelhead Recreational Fishery

- Effective 12:01 AM June 25, 2020 angling for, and retention of all sockeye and steelhead is prohibited in the Columbia River from the mouth upstream to the Oregon/Washington border (upstream of McNary Dam).

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No additional Joint State hearings are currently scheduled.
- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 1 PM Tuesday June 30, 2020 via teleconference to consider treaty summer commercial fisheries.
