Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon and Steelhead Fisheries

The Dalles Dam upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge (Pasco, WA)

- Effective 12:01 AM Sunday November 1 through Thursday December 31, 2020, the daily adult salmonid bag limit for the ongoing fishery in the mainstem Columbia River from The Dalles Dam upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge near Pasco, WA may include up to one hatchery steelhead. All other regulations remain in effect including those specific to retention of jacks and the required use of barbless hooks.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No hearings are scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff will recommend additional hearings as needed.
