Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon and Steelhead Fisheries

The Dalles Dam upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge (Pasco, WA)

Effective Friday January 1 through Wednesday March 31, 2021, the daily bag limit for the ongoing salmonid fishery in the mainstem Columbia River from The Dalles Dam upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge near Pasco, WA is limited to one hatchery steelhead. All other regulations remain in effect including the required use of barbless hooks.

Effective January 1, 2021, permanent salmonid regulations will be in effect for the mainstem Columbia River downstream of The Dalles Dam and in the John Day River

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No hearings are scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff will continue to monitor the fisheries and stock status.
