Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Non-Treaty Fisheries

Mainstem Commercial Late-Fall Fishery

- **Rescind** the following periods previously adopted for Zones 4/5:
7 PM Sunday October 9 to 7 AM Monday October 10 (12 hours)
7 PM Wednesday October 12 to 7 AM Thursday October 13 (12 hours)

Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon Fishery

Buoy 10 upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge

- Effective 11:59 PM Friday October 7, 2022 retention of Chinook in the mainstem Columbia River from Buoy 10 upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge near Pasco, Washington is prohibited.
