## **Joint State Action**

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

## White Sturgeon Recreational Fisheries

John Day Pool (John Day Dam upstream to McNary Dam)

• Effective 11:59 PM Wednesday March 9, 2022 the retention of white sturgeon in John Day Pool and adjacent tributaries is <u>prohibited</u>.

For all recreational sturgeon fisheries, catch limits, seasonal sturgeon spawning sanctuary closures, and other restrictions in the 2022 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations pamphlet remain in effect the entire year, including catch and release angling allowed during periods closed to sturgeon retention.
