The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fishery

Buoy 10 upstream to west Puget Island

- Effective 11:59 PM Tuesday August 30, retention of Chinook is <u>prohibited</u> in the mainstem Columbia River from the Buoy 10 line upstream to a line at the west end of Puget Island.

- All other permanent regulations in the 2022 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations Pamphlet remain in effect.
