Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife May 31, 2023

Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fishery

Downstream of Bonneville Dam

- Effective Thursday June 1 through Thursday June 15, 2023 angling for, and retention of, all salmon and steelhead is prohibited in the mainstem Columbia River from the Tongue Point/Rocky Point line upstream to Bonneville Dam.
- All other permanent rules remain in effect.

Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following action:

Select Area Fisheries

Youngs Bay Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 70)

- Modified the previously-adopted spring season fishing periods as follows with modifications in **bold**.

Youngs Bay 6 AM Monday May 29 – **6 AM Thursday June 1** (3 days)

Upper Youngs Bay only 6 AM Monday June 5 – 9 AM Friday June 9 (4 days)

All other previously-adopted regulations remain in effect.
