Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following action:

Select Area Fisheries

Youngs Bay Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 70)

Modified the previously adopted winter season fishing period as follows with modification in **bold**.

Period: 5:00 PM – 9:00 PM Thursday March 21 (4 hours)

Area: The Youngs Bay Select Area is defined as waters of Youngs Bay and Youngs River southeasterly of the Highway 101 Bridge upstream to the regulatory marker(s) at the confluence of the Klaskanine and Youngs rivers, including the Walluski River downstream of the Highway 202 Bridge, and the Lewis and Clark River north (downstream) of the overhead power lines approximately 500 feet south (upstream) of Barrett Slough. During the winter season, the upstream boundary in the Lewis and Clark River is the Alternate Highway 101 Bridge (Lewis and Clark Bridge).

All other previously adopted regulations remain in effect.

Permanent regulations including rules related to transportation and lighted buoys remain in effect.

Future Meetings

No Compact/Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time. Joint Staff will monitor the fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed.
