Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Spring Chinook Fisheries

Modified the following on-going fishery with modification in **bold**:

Downstream of Bonneville Dam

Effective Saturday June 8 through Saturday June 15, 2024 the upstream boat boundary is the **Bonneville Dam deadline**.

All other previously adopted and permanent regulations remain in effect.

Adopted the following fishery:

Bonneville Dam to Oregon/Washington State Line (upstream of McNary Dam)

Dates: Saturday June 8 through Saturday June 15, 2024

Area: Tower Island power lines (approximately six miles below The Dalles Dam) upstream to Oregon/Washington border, plus the Oregon and Washington banks between Bonneville Dam and the Tower Island power lines.

Daily bag limit: Two adult hatchery salmonids (Chinook or steelhead only) per day, but only one may be a Chinook.

Shad may also be retained. All other permanent regulations apply.

Future Meetings

No Compact or Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time. Joint Staff will monitor fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed.

The treaty tribes may request a Compact hearing for June 27 or 28 to consider additional commercial gillnet openings.
