FISHERY RECOMMENDATIONS

The joint staff is recommending the fishery scheduled for August 24, 2006 be rescinded.

- Impacts set aside for August fisheries have been met.
- Additional fishing in August may jeopardize full (Zones 1-5) fishing opportunity in September to target Chinook. The 2006 Fall Allocation agreement includes expectations of at least one target Chinook fishery during the week of September 17.
