Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon/Steelhead Fisheries

Bonneville Dam to the Oregon/Washington State Line (upstream of McNary Dam)

- Effective 11:59 PM Monday April 29, angling for and retention of salmon and steelhead is prohibited in the mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam to the Oregon/Washington state line (upstream of McNary Dam).
