^ For May 23, 2022 --Allowable sales were for a maximum of sixteen (16) adipose fin-clipped adult Chinook salmon that could be possessed or sold by each participating vessel. The first 16 adult hatchery fish were to be retained, and no additional drifts could be conducted once the adult Chinook limit had been reached. Jack Chinook less than 24 inches in total length (and also adipose fin-clipped) were allowed to be kept and sold, and not included in the landing limit. A maximum of three white sturgeon with a fork length of 44-50 inches may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday). The white sturgeon possession and sales limit applies to mainstem fisheries only.
