3. No commercial smelt fishery occurred during 2012 (closed since Dec. 1, 2010). Effective May 17, 2010, Columbia River eulachon were federally-listed as threatened under the ESA

4. Effective July 7, 2006, green sturgeon (southern DPS) were federally-listed as threatened under the ESA; retention has been prohibited during Columbia River commercial fisheries since July 6, 2006.
