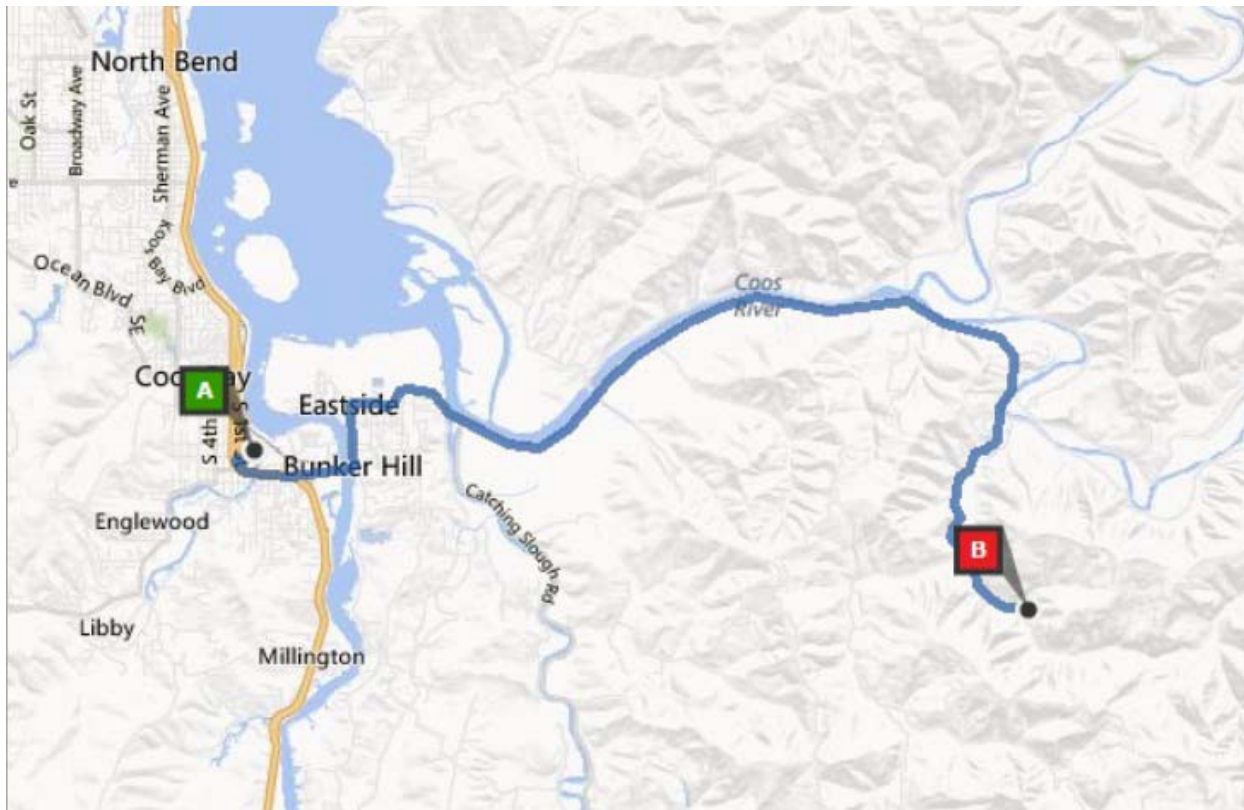

## Directions to the Morgan Creek Education Center.



1a. Heading south on 101 from Coos Bay, after Fred Meyer there will be a light at the 7/11 (Flanagan Rd) go through the light. Make sure to be in the left lane before or shortly after this light. In about a ¼ mile, merge into the double left turn lane, stay in the right lane of the two left lanes and follow it across 101. It will be signed for Coos River & Allegany. Continue straight (do not turn left as the left lane will force you too).

1b. Heading North. Just as you come into Coos Bay, speed reduced to 30, look for a sign on the right that says “Coos River & Allegany right 1/4 mile.” Proceed to the second stop light and turn right where signed “Coos River & Allegany”.

2. In about ¾ mile, you will cross a large bridge follow the road as it curves to the left.

3. After a long straight stretch, about ¾ mile, you will climb a hill. At the top you will turn right onto D St. (there is a right turn lane). Stay on D St. for about 2.5 miles, you will be next to the Coos River.

4. When you see a large green steel bridge over the Coos River prepare to turn left. About a ¼ mile before the bridge is a left turn lane signed “Myrtle Tree County Park”. Turn left. You are now on S. Coos River Lane.

5. Follow S. Coos River Lane for about 4.5 miles to Daniels Ck. Rd. For the first 4 miles you will be along the Coos River, then you will head up a hill away from the water. Once you leave the water prepare to turn right in about ½ mile onto Daniels Ck. Rd. It will be just before a high concrete bridge (don't worry if you miss the turn just over the bridge is a boat ramp you can turn around at).

6. After turning onto Daniels Ck. Rd Follow the curving road for about 1.7 miles. Morgan Ck. lane will be on your left on the outside of a fairly sharp right hand curve (it does sneak up on you). Once you have turned on Morgan Ck. follow it about a mile to the Morgan Ck. facility.
