Joint State Action

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Salmon/Steelhead Fisheries

Modified the following previously-adopted fishery (modifications in **bold**):

Astoria-Megler Bridge to Highway 395 Bridge at Pasco, WA

- Effective **Saturday June 27** through Sunday July 5 in the mainstem Columbia River from the Astoria-Megler Bridge upstream to the Highway 395 Bridge at Pasco, WA., sockeye may be retained as part of the daily adult salmon/steelhead bag limit. The daily bag limit during this timeframe includes two adult salmonids of which only one may be a steelhead. All other temporary regulations applicable to summer-season salmon/steelhead fisheries in the Columbia River zone remain in effect.

All other permanent regulations in the 2026 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations book remain in effect, including catch limits for jack salmon.
