Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following action:

Select Area Fisheries

Youngs Bay Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 70)

Modified the following previously-adopted fishing period; modification in **bold**:

Period: 7 PM Monday, August 31 – **7 AM Friday, September 4** (3.5 days)

7 PM Monday, September 7 to Noon Friday October 30 (53 days)

Area: The Youngs Bay Select Area is defined as waters of Youngs Bay and Youngs River southeasterly of the Highway 101 Bridge upstream to the regulatory marker(s) at the confluence of the Klaskanine and Youngs rivers, including the Walluski River downstream of the Highway 202 Bridge, and the Lewis and Clark River north (downstream) of the overhead power lines approximately 500 feet south (upstream) of Barrett Slough.

All other previously-adopted regulations remain in effect.

Permanent regulations, including rules related to transportation and lighted buoys, remain in effect.
