## Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

### Treaty Indian Fisheries

Allowed commercial sales of fish landed in the following fishery:

#### **Zone 6 Commercial Winter Setline Fishery (The Dalles Pool)**

Season:	6 AM Monday February 2 through 6 PM Saturday February 7	(5.5 days)
Area:	The Dalles Pool	
Gear:	Setlines	
Sanctuaries:	Standard closed areas applicable to setline gear.	
Allowable Sales:	Sturgeon from 43 to 54 inches fork length may be sold or kept for subsistence purposes. Fish landed during the open period may be sold after the period concludes.	
Reporting Rules:	24-hour quick reporting required for Washington buyers, pursuant to WAC 220-352-315 except that landings must be reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket.	
	Oregon buyers are required to electronically submit fish receiving tickets pursuant to OAR 635-006-0210.
