The New River Access Area is a cooperative program between several private landowners and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Access and Habitat Program to maintain public hunting access on private lands and increase access to public land. The New River Access Area south of Bandon, OR provides public hunting opportunities for waterfowl. All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and Seasons apply.

Wed, Fri, Sat: Sep 29, 2018 - Jan 27, 2019
All Days: Feb 23 - Mar 10, 2019

Zone B1, B2, and B3
Sat and Sun: Sep 29, 2018 - Jan 27, 2019
All Days: Feb 23 - Mar 10, 2019

Consult Game Bird Regulations for duck and goose open season dates

Access Permission:

Hunters must obtain permission prior to hunting on the property. Permission can be obtained by contacting the landowner by phone at the following numbers - please call only between 5 and 8 PM Monday - Friday. Reservations will be booked on a first come, first served basis. Hunters who make reservations to hunt during a particular week, are ineligible to hunt the area the following week. Landowners reserve the right to refuse permission and close areas due to normal ranch operations.

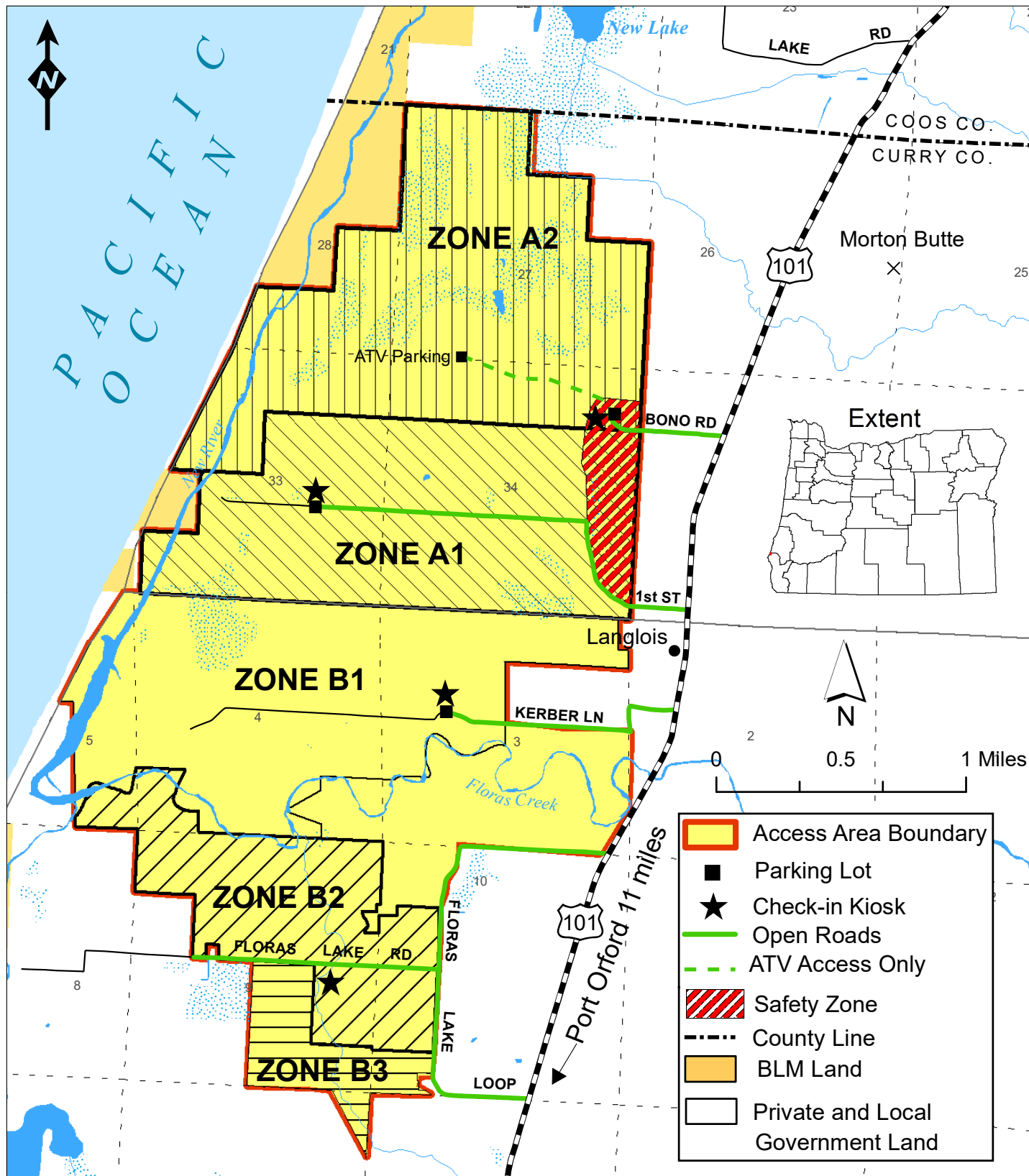
