The Ontario City Access Area is a cooperative program between the City of Ontario, and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Access and Habitat Program to allow public hunting access on City of Ontario land. The Access Area provides public hunting opportunities for deer, pheasant, waterfowl, dove, California quail, and predators. All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and Season apply.

Access Allowed:
 Year Round Except
 Skyline Area is Closed
 through December 31, 2020

Area Regulations:

- Hunters must fill out Free Access Permit
- Welcome to Hunt – upland bird, waterfowl and archery big game
- Foot Traffic Only
- No camping or fires
- No hunting within settling pond boundary fence
- Enter only at designated parking areas

Skyline Parcel

- DEQ requires users to stay 100 feet from actively irrigated areas
- Gun Range for Ontario PD only

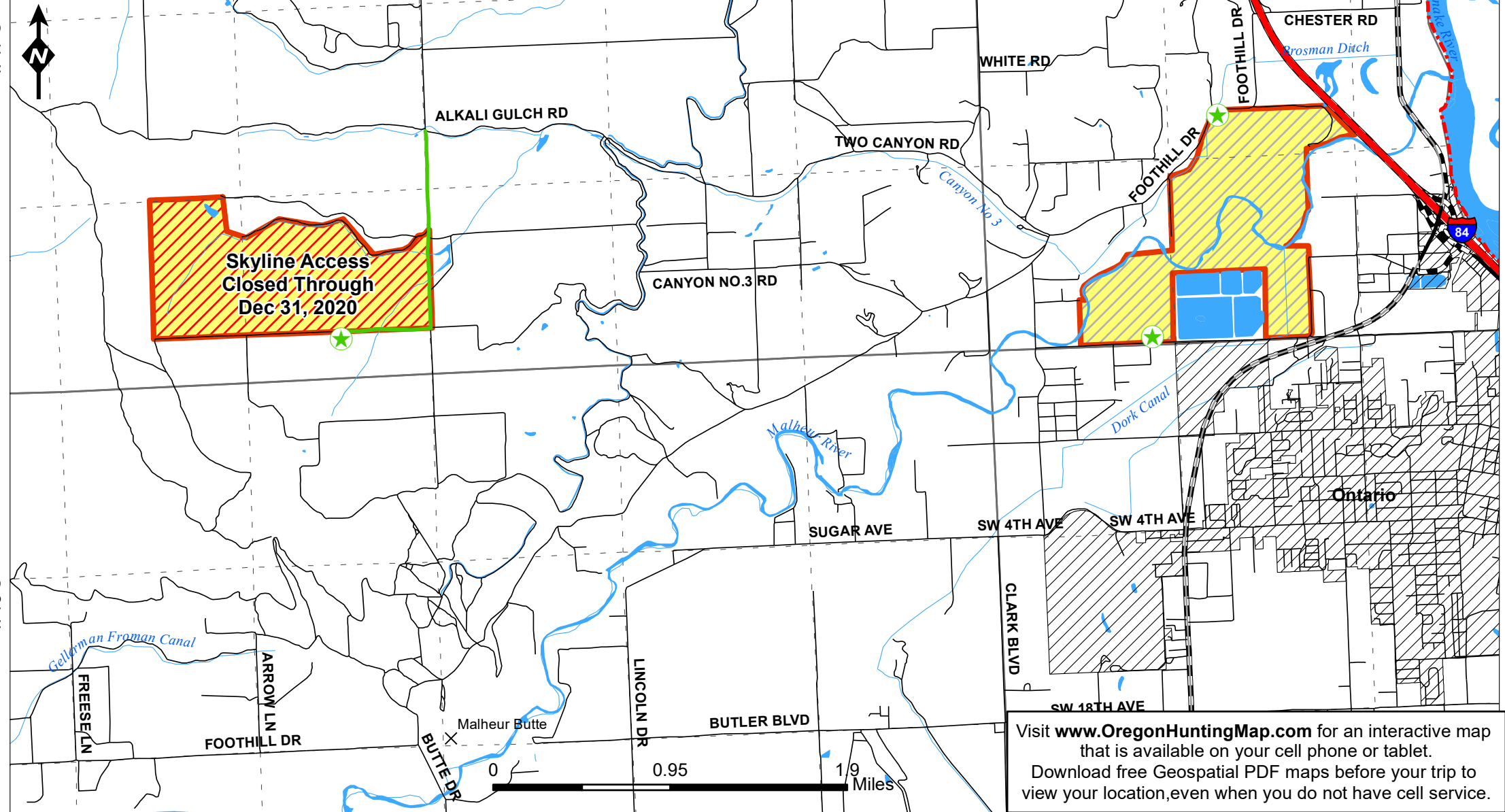
