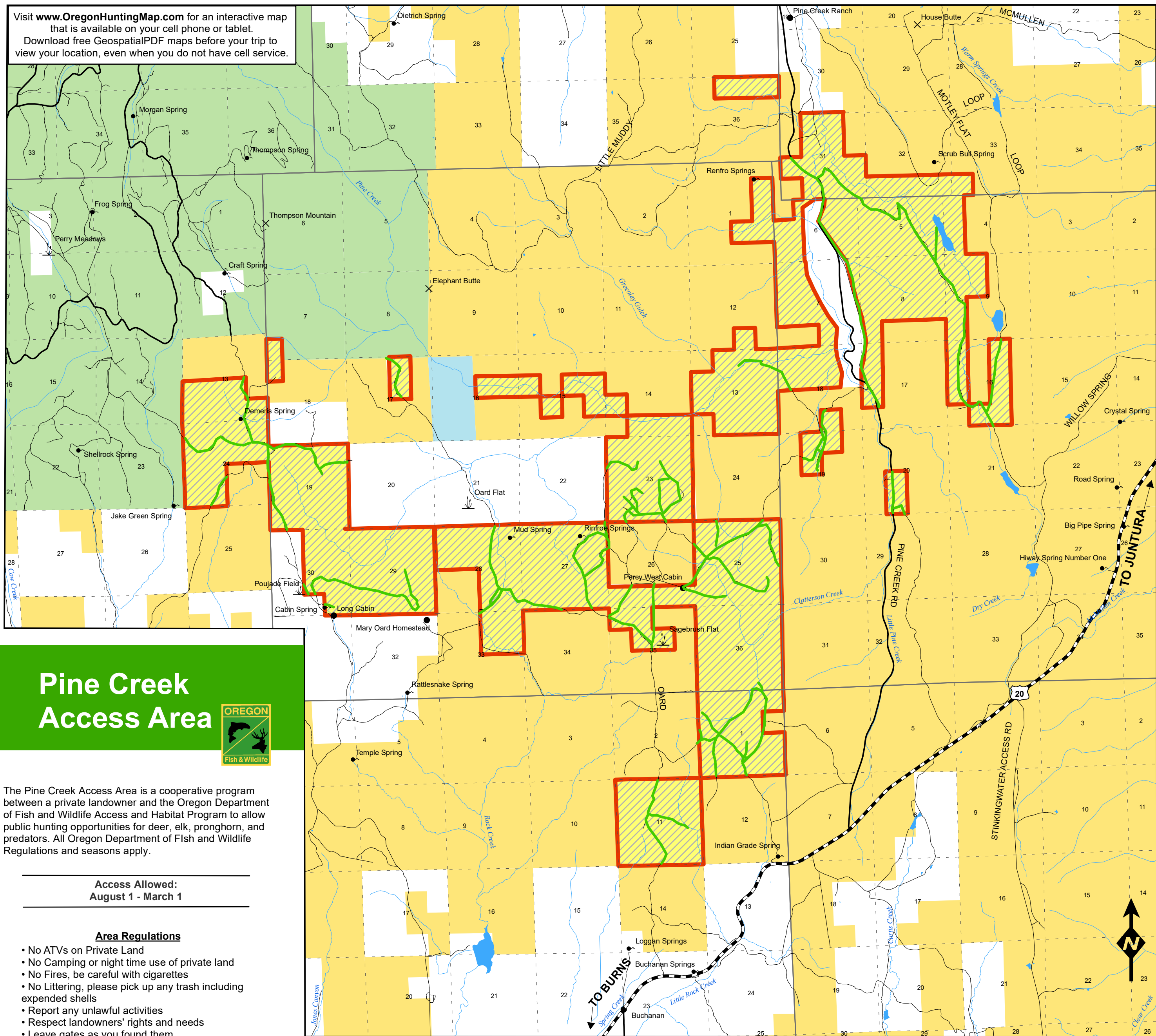

Pine Creek Access Area



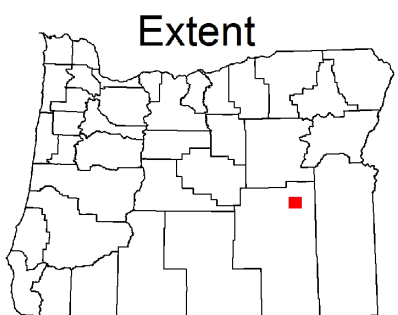
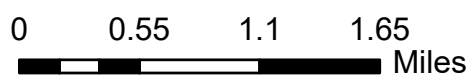
The Pine Creek Access Area is a cooperative program between a private landowner and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Access and Habitat Program to allow public hunting opportunities for deer, elk, pronghorn, and predators. All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and seasons apply.

Access Allowed:
August 1 - March 1

Area Regulations

- No ATVs on Private Land
- No Camping or night time use of private land
- No Fires, be careful with cigarettes
- No Littering, please pick up any trash including expended shells
- Report any unlawful activities
- Respect landowners' rights and needs
- Leave gates as you found them
- Vehicle Travel only on roads mapped and posted as open access road

Hunting on private lands is a privilege, not a right. Private land hunting opportunities will remain in the future only if the property and rights of private landowners are respected! Abuse it and you will lose it!
