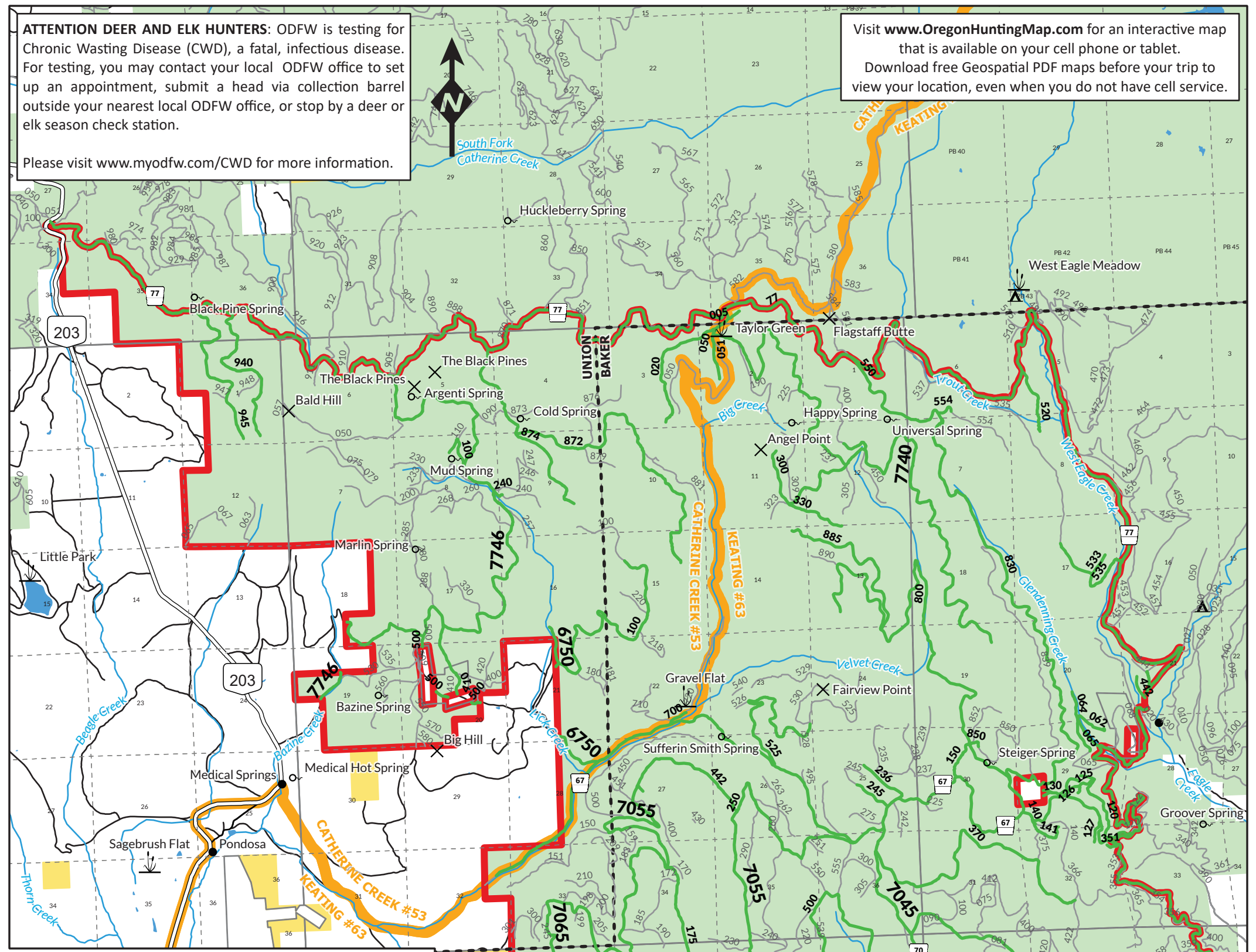

For testing, you may contact your local ODFW office to set up an appointment, submit a head via collection barrel outside your nearest local ODFW office, or stop by a deer or elk season check station.

Period of Restrictions:
April 30th through December 1st

Only those roads shown in green are open for motor vehicle travel during the period of restrictions. Motor vehicles may also be used within 300 feet of open roads for camping, big game retrieval, and permitted firewood collection.

Motorized vehicle travel within the Travel Management Area boundary on all other roads and trails, and cross-country is prohibited except by special permit from the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest.

All "electric assist" vehicles are unlawful on closed roads and cross-country.

OBJECTIVES:

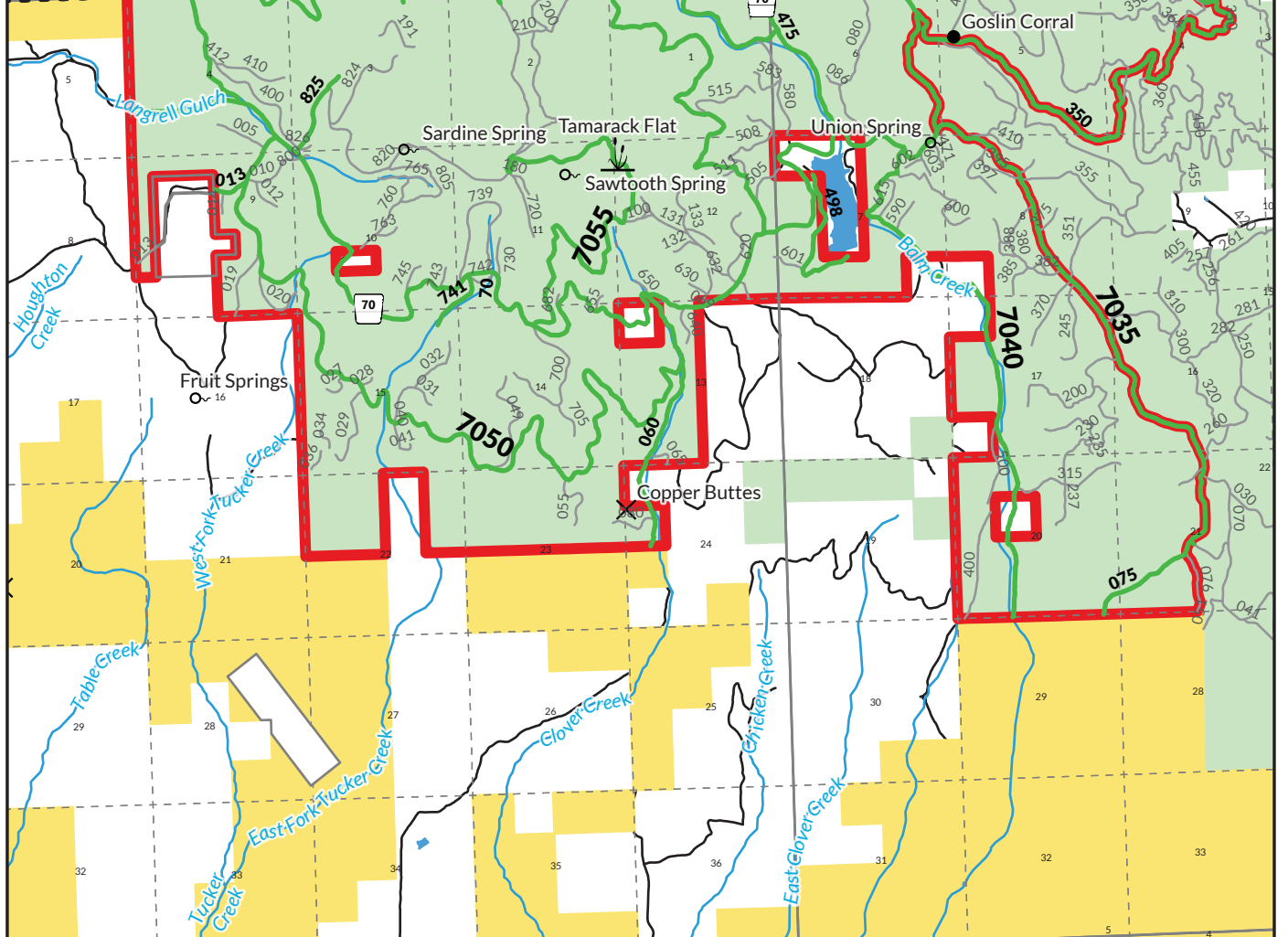
1. Protect soils and wildlife habitat

4. Promote quality hunting



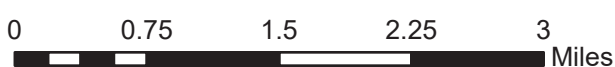
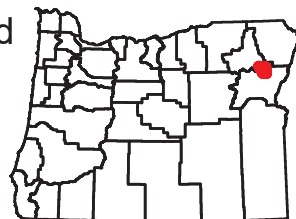
